

AP Prize / Refund Payments

The AP Prize / Refund Payments online form is used to submit Prize, Refund, or Royalty information to Accounts Payable for payment processing.

Backup documentation is to be retained in your department and not submitted to AP.

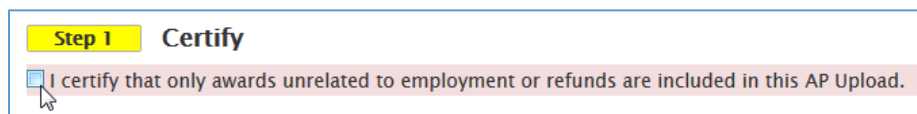
Some substantiation documents may still be required by Purchasing (W8-Ben and W9) and Research Accounting. You will be prompted how to get those documents to the proper office.

There are entries on the form that are required. These are highlighted or shaded in red.

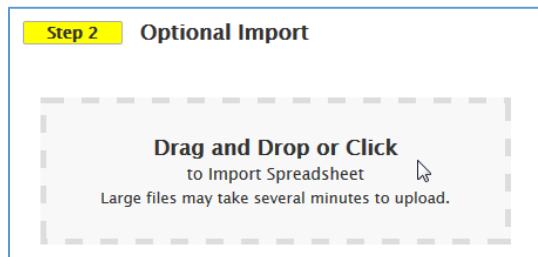
Entering a Batch

Step 1: The Certify check box is required to be checked.



The red shading disappears when the box is checked.

Step 2: This is step optional. You may choose to import an AP Upload Template spreadsheet that you have previously entered the data into. You can click anywhere in the 'Drag and Drop' box to browse for the file or you can drag the file to the box.



Step 3: The Direct Entry step requires you to manually enter the data. The user submitting the payment data should fill in the Description and verify all the other information is correct. The user information is populated based on your login authentication. If a spreadsheet has been imported, the user and department information is loaded from the spreadsheet.

Step 4: If manually entering the data, you can use the Defaults section to assist in the entry. The Defaults in conjunction with the **Add Rows** functionality will allow *multiple transaction lines* to be populated with the *same data*. You can change the data in the Defaults and it will *only affect* those transactions that are added until you change the Defaults and add again.

Defaults - Will autofill the row cells when added.

Step 5: Adding transaction rows is accomplished with the **Add Rows** button. You can change the number of rows you are adding. The values in the Defaults section will be applied *only* to the new rows being added.

The Save button saves your entries until you submit them.

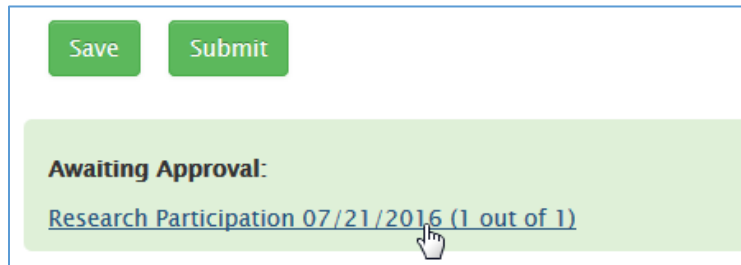
Once saved, the batch will show at the TOP as INCOMPLETE until you submit the batch.

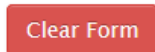
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The Submit button will submit the transactions to the Department or College Controller for approval. This step will outline how to submit the documents to Purchasing and/ or Research Accounting

Deleting a batch

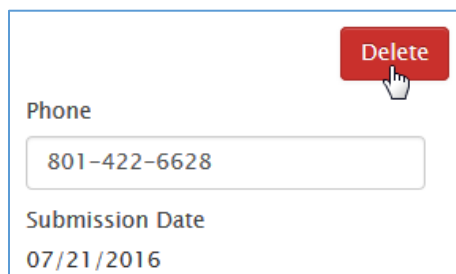
Only saved batches in Incomplete status (listed in the blue shaded area) may be deleted.

Step 1: Use the “Clear Form” button if any data is in form

Step 2: Double click on batch to be deleted

Step 3: Remove all lines from the batch using the “Remove” button

Step 4: Use the “Delete” button located above the User Phone field

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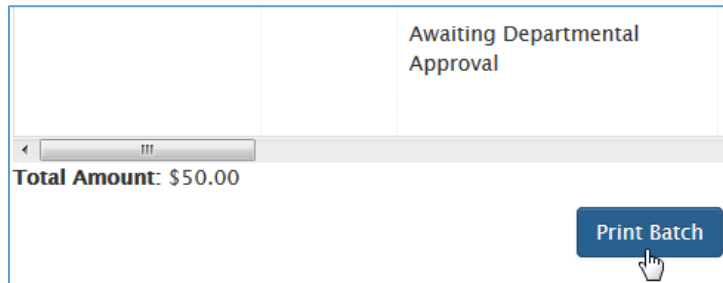
Printing a batch

Only batches awaiting approval (listed in the green shaded area) may be printed.

Step 1: Use the “Clear Form” button if any data is on the form

Step 2: Double click on the batch to be printed

Step 3: Use the “Print Batch” button located at the bottom of the transaction entry grid.



Step 4: Print from .pdf
